

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
WATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS
HAVRE DE GRACE, MARYLAND

Sealed proposals for construction of improvements to the City of Havre de Grace, MD water treatment plant (WTP) will be received by the City of Havre de Grace at City Hall, located at 711 Pennington Avenue, Havre de Grace, MD 21078 until 2:00 p.m. local time on November 21, 2007. The completed Bid Form must be received by the above-referenced dates and times for the bid to be considered valid. Sealed proposals received in accordance with these requirements will be publicly opened and read aloud at the same location on November 21, 2007 at 2:00 p.m.

Work of this contract comprises the project for replacement of three WTP finished water pumps, providing PLC-based VFD control of the pumps at the WTP, related piping and instrumentation improvements, installation of a packaged engine generator system, and replacement of the carbon feed system.

An optional pre-bid meeting will be held on October 31, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. local time at the Havre de Grace WTP located at 415 St. John Street, Havre de Grace, MD.

Copies of the plans and specifications may be obtained starting October 23, 2007 at the Havre de Grace City Hall upon submission of a plan deposit in the form of a check or money order payable to City of Havre de Grace in the amount of \$100.00 per set. If mailing of documents is requested, a separate check payable to City of Havre de Grace in the amount of \$50.00 per set must be included to cover handling and postage fees or a UPS or FedEx account number shall be provided to the City. No refunds will be made for the return of plans and specifications.



Questions must include the project name (Havre de Grace Water Treatment Plant Improvements) and Contract No. 1-31-9020-07 in the subject heading. No response will be given to questions received less than 14 days before the bid date.

Each Bid must be accompanied by Bid security made payable to City of Havre de Grace in an amount of 5 percent of Bidder's maximum Bid price and in the form of a certified check or bank check or a Bid Bond. If, upon acceptance of his bid, a Bidder fails to enter into a Contract with the City of Havre de Grace, the Bid security shall be forfeited to and become the property of the City.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 120 days after the date of the bid opening. The successful bidder must furnish a 100% Performance and Payment Bond with a surety company satisfactory to the City of Havre de Grace and conforming to the prerequisite requirements of Article 5 of the General Conditions.

The City of Havre de Grace reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.

Bidders are required to certify, under penalty of perjury, that bids have been prepared without collusion with other bidders, subcontractors, suppliers, etc. This certification is included with the Bid Proposal which each Bidder must sign in the space provided.
