Executive Order 2015-02

WHEREAS, the City of Havre de Grace owns and maintains Tydings Memorial Park at the foot of Commerce Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Havre de Grace has expanded Tydings Memorial Park beyond the Promenade and the Concord Point Lighthouse with additional waterfront parkland along Concord Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Havre de Grace is committed to providing waterfront parks for its citizens' use and enjoyment and to enhance the quality of life in the City; and

WHEREAS, the expansion of Tydings Memorial Park and the variety of potential uses of these areas requires careful study and consideration.


NOW THEREFORE, be it decided and ordered by the Mayor of the City of Havre de Grace on this 20<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2015.

1. That a Tydings Memorial Park Commission is created ("Commission").
2. The Commission members and the chairperson shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Mayor;
3. The Commission shall consist of twelve (12) members: two (2) council members; two (2) members of the City staff and eight (8) citizens of the City of Havre de Grace;

4. The Commission shall study, analyze and report to the Mayor on the following topics:
  - A. Band shell type and location
  - B. Lighting
  - C. Playground location and equipment
  - D. Swale area use
  - E. Sidewalks
  - F. Carnival
  - G. Seafood Festival
  - H. Special Events
  - I. Other topics as assigned by the Mayor
5. The Commission shall meet not less than twice monthly for the next four (4) months and provide a written report to the Mayor on not less than items A, B, C and D listed above by December 18, 2015.
6. The Commission shall provide any further reports to the Mayor by February 1, 2016.
