

Scheduling a Bulk Item for Curbside Collection on **Wednesdays** ~

Note: There is no charge for this service.



- Please remove or secure open the doors of bulk items (freezer, oven, refrigerator,...) to prevent a child or pet from becoming trapped inside.
- Place the bulk items where you normally place your trash, recyclables and yard waste for collection.
- The City cannot enter private property to collect bulk refuse.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF BULK ITEMS

This service is intended to help with the **occasional need** for a bulk item to be removed. This service is not for a total home or room clean-out, moving or renovation projects.

WHO can participate?

This expanded service is for residents within the City limits who receive City collection service for trash, recyclables and yard waste. Bulk Collection is also provided for the development of Bulle Rock - individual homes only.

- This Bulk Collection Service does not include residents of apartments, condominiums, businesses, and commercial properties.

WHEN will this collection occur?

WEDNESDAYS - must call to schedule.

- No bulk collections on a holiday or during the holiday week.

HOW many items may be scheduled?

Residents may request up to 3 bulk items to be collected at one time.

- Only those items requested and put on our schedule for that day will be collected.
- We **do not remove bags** of household waste for this service. Bags go out with regular trash collection.

Note: This Bulk collection service as defined herein is subject to change.

- Tires - off rim
- Toilet - *Limit 1 per collection*
- Vacuum cleaner, shop vac

- Air conditioner, fan
- Aluminum siding
- Bed frame
- Bicycles, bicycle wheels

- Chair
- Dehumidifier
- Dog cage
- Dishwasher, microwave
- Exercise machine
- File cabinet

- Hot water tank
- Refrigerator
- Stove

ITEMS NOT COLLECTED BY THE CITY

The City will not collect construction materials. (Examples include: lumber, paneling, drywall, concrete, tile, decking, fencing, bricks, doors, windows, showers, tubs, fluorescent bulbs, etc.)

To dispose of items **not collected by the City**, you have three (3) options:

1. Take to the Scarboro Landfill **Ph: 410-638-3018**

2. Contact Waste Industries **Ph: 410-457-0404**
to arrange for a curbside pick-up (There is a fee.)
3. Contact a private hauler.
